Probably lost about 15-20 QSOs while tinkering with the problem. I've heard that there is a lot of DX that only shows up on RTTY. I was hoping to work something new, but nothing heard. Just the usual suspects. But I'll keep trying. There were a couple of hours where I thought someone might have called a recess and I didn't get the word. My rate was even lower than one would expect for a QRP station, given the other hours I had been operating. Maybe everyone decided to take their hour breaks at about the same time. I'll remember that when planning mine for next year :-)
When the contest was over, I discovered that only one side of my 450-ohm window line feed was connected for my 20m antenna. My ATU matched it just fine, so I didn't realize there was a problem. And yet I managed 108 QSOs through that connection. I wonder if I could have worked 216 if both leads had been connected :-)
